CCSIT PAID HOMAGE TO LATE SHRI ATAL BIHARI VAJPAYEE JI

(17th August, 2018)

College of Computing Sciences and Information Technology, Teerthanker Mahaveer University, Moradabad, paid homage to our former Prime Minister, a great political leader of the age, poet, journalist and orator Late Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Ji (25 December, 1924 – 16 August, 2018), who passed away on August 16, 2018 in New Delhi, in a prayer meeting (*Shraddhanjali Sabha*) at 11:30 a.m. on 17th August, 2018. All members of CCSIT including the Principal, faculty members and students paid their tribute and gratitude by offering flowers on the photo of Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Ji. In his condolence message, Prof. Rakesh Kumar Dwivedi, Principal, CCSIT, shared his views about Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Ji and said that Vajpayee Ji was a great leader of the era who was popular not only in India but also world over. He was respected by one and all. Prof. Dwivedi discussed about the concept of "*Rajadharma*" given by Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Ji in detail and asked the audience to follow it. He also shared some famous lines of the poems of Vajpayee Ji –



"Kya haar mein kya jeet mein kinchit nahi bhaibheet main, sangarsh path par jo mila yeh bhi sahi wo bhi sahi, vardaana nahi manguga, ho kuchh bhi par haar nahi manunga."

"Main jee bhar jiya, Mai man se marun, Laut kar aaunga, Kooch se kyon darun."

"Chhote man se koi bada nahi hota, Toote man se koi khada nahi hota."

"Badhayen aati hai aayen, Ghire parlay ki ghor ghataayen, paon ke niche angaare, sir par barasen yadi jwalaayen, Nij haathon mein haste haste aag lagaa kar jalana hoga, Kadam milakar chalana hoga."

"Hindu tana mana hindu jivana raga raga hindu merā paricaya.

Mai akhila viśva kā guru mahāna detā vidyā kā amara dāna.

Maine dikhalāyā muktimārga maine sikhālāyā brahma jñāna.

Mai eka bindu paripūrṇa sindhu hai yaha merā hindu samāja.

Merā isakā saṁbandha amara mai vyakti aura yaha hai samāja."

Prof. Dwivedi said that Vajpayee Ji was an amazing poet, a unique politician and a divine person. He appealed to the gathering to get inspiration from the life of Shri Vajpayee Ji and said that we need to learn "*Rajadharma*", "*Rashtraprem*" and "*Naitikata*" from his personality. SHORT TERM COURSES

Mobile Application Development Workshop

IBM Trainer provided two days Mobile Application Development training to students. The vision of the university is to develop and promote the spirit of science and technology to students, enabling them to have hands on feel of technology and its applications.

During the workshop students were introduced to basics of Android OS work through modules throughout the day. These modules include designing effective navigation, managing audio playback, hooking up widgets such as buttons, list views, applying skins, themes, interfacing GPS, camera etc. Ms. Khushboo IBM trainers who conducted this workshop has relevant experience in the field and it was Coordinated by Dr. Rajeev Kumar, IBM Course Corrdinator, CCSIT.

"Android: Mobile Apps Development"

"Android: Mobile Apps Development" Short term program conducted by CCSIT, is a unique short term program which is coordinated by Deependra Rastogi and Deepak Kumar with support by principal of CCSIT Prof. Rakesh Kr. 3D SCULPTING TECHNOLOGY

Mr. Pradeep Kumar Gupta, Assistant Professor, CCSIT



Digital sculpting, also known as **sculpt modeling** or **3D sculpting**, is the use of software that offers tools to push, pull, smooth, grab, pinch or otherwise manipulate a digital object as if it were made of a real-life substance such as clay.



The geometry used in digital sculpting programs to represent the model can vary; each offers different benefits and limitations. The majority of digital sculpting tools on the market use mesh-based geometry, in which an object is represented by an interconnected surface mesh of polygons that can be pushed and pulled around.

This is somewhat similar to the physical process of beating copper plates to sculpt a scene in relief. Other digital sculpting tools use voxel-based geometry, in which the volume of the object is the basic element. Material can be added

and removed, much like sculpting in clay. Still other tools make use of more than one basic geometry representation.

USES OF SCULPTING:

Sculpting can often introduce details to meshes that would otherwise have been difficult or impossible to create using traditional 3D modeling techniques. This makes it preferable for achieving photorealistic and hyperrealistic results, though, many stylized results are achieved as well. Sculpting is primarily used in high poly organic modeling (the creation of 3D models which consist mainly of curves or irregular surfaces, as opposed to hard surface modeling). It is also used by auto manufacturers in their design of new cars. It can create the source meshes for low poly game models used in video games. In conjunction with other 3D modeling and texturing techniques and Displacement and Normal mapping, it can greatly enhance the appearance of game meshes often to the point of photorealism.



SCULPTING PROGRAMS AND SOFTWARE:

There are so many sculpting programs are available nowadays some popular ones are:

- 3D-Coat ·Cinema-4D ·Geomagic Freeform ·Mudbox ·Sculptris ·ZBrush

Beside these specific sculpting application traditional 3D softwares (Autodesk Maya, 3D Max, Modo, Sketchup etc.) are also including some sculpting features.
