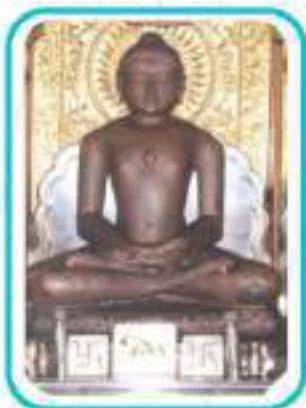

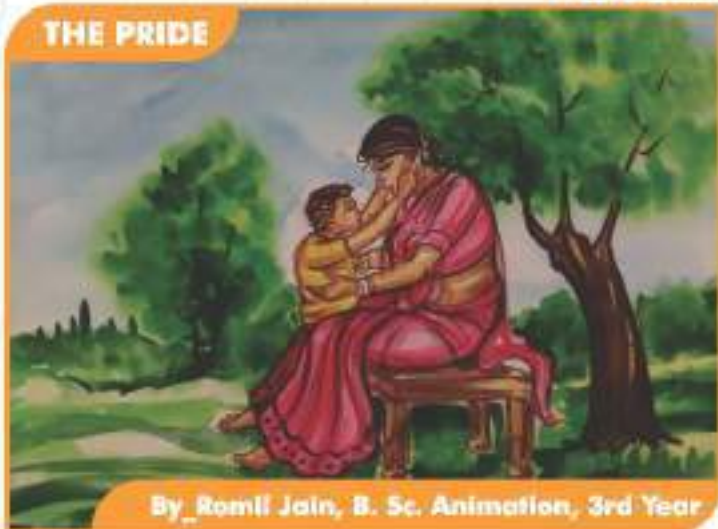

A typical example of this bias was the antiquated misconception that wives were properties of their husbands and as such whatever possession a woman toiled to purchase automatically belonged to her husband irrespective of whether he was a lazy drone.

The prejudice against women was unbearable for women and even appalling to gentlemen like me "winks" so somebody somewhere had to do something to alter the unfair circumstances some how- thus feminism came into the picture. Feminism has alleviated the plight of women significantly and that's a positive achievement for social progress but feminism is absolutely wrong for basing efforts to salvage women from injustice on 'equality'. Women and men are unique and complimentary in the sense that there are certain things/roles which are specifically for women such as childbearing likewise there are things/roles which are specifically for men such as Christians I priesthood and also men need women and women need men for the sake of balance. This doesn't imply that all the men and women of the world need to get married to each other. It however means that our world won't be okay without the availability of both sexes in their natural, unpolluted orientation thus there's no logical basis for the ideology of purported equality between the sexes. What's obtainable for both is 'equity', a concept which I'll deliberate on some other day

Nevertheless equity here is about according to the different sees regards and dues which correspond to their unique characteristics without falsely equating them to each other.
